



## Rules and Guidelines call for art

- The call is open to the following artistic categories: painting, sculpture, photography, graphic art, illustration, and is addressed to both professionals and non-professionals, residing in Italy or abroad, with no age restrictions as long as they are of legal age.
- The application for participation must be submitted using the dedicated form (available on the website <a href="www.ecomuseoficana.it">www.ecomuseoficana.it</a>). The complete documentation must be sent by email to <a href="mailto:atterrati@gmail.com">atterrati@gmail.com</a> no later than February 3, 2025.
- The email must have the subject line "BANDO ATTERRATI! CALL FOR ART" and must include the following, under penalty of exclusion from the selection process:
  - the completed application form (available on the website www.ecomuseoficana.it)
  - a copy of a valid identity document;
  - between 5 and 10 images of the artworks (minimum file size in jpeg format) with the title, description, dimensions, weight and technique for each
  - a short biography of the artist and the project presented
  - an updated CV.
- Any information regarding this call can be requested from the organizers via email at atterrati@gmail.com.
- Selected artists will be contacted starting from **second half of February 2025** via email.

  They will be able to arrange the details of the exhibition with the organizers. The exhibition period will be communicated after the selection, and the maximum number of works to be displayed will be determined based on their type and dimensions.

  The project and the artists will be presented during a press conference.
- **TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:** 
  - Paintings on panels, canvas, or other painting supports, max 100x100 cm;
  - Drawings, maximum size: 50x50 cm made using any technique, mounted on a rigid support and equipped with a hook on the back for hanging;
  - Black and white or color photographic prints from negatives or digital files, maximum size: 50x50 cm, mounted on a rigid support and equipped with a hook on the back for hanging;
  - Sculptures, maximum base: 50x50 cm, maximum height: 100 cm, and weight not exceeding 3 kg.
- The arrangement of the exhibition spaces must be carried out according to the times and methods communicated by the organizers, who will assist the artists with technical and logistical aspects.
- Each exhibition will last for 2 weeks (unless an extension is agreed with the artist). An opening event will be held in the afternoon of the first day to present the artist and the works to the public. The exhibition will be accessible free of charge during the visitor center's opening hours.
- During the exhibition, the artist may promote their work using advertising material. The sale of artworks is **NOT PERMITTED** during this period.
- The selected artists are asked to donate a work that will become part of the Ecomuseum Collection (to be chosen from those exhibited or created specifically)

## Informations call for art

The Ecomuseum of Earth Houses in Villa Ficana, Macerata (MC), offers artists a space to exhibit and promote their works and artistic creations.

It is not an art gallery but aims to be a **meeting point**, a place for **knowledge-sharing**, and a platform to **spread creativity**.
